

26TH SEPTEMBER 2010 CENSUS NIGHT

FROM: 26TH SEPT. - 10TH OCT

- Census night is September 26, 2010.
- You will be enumerated where you spent **CENSUS NIGHT**.
- Stay at your usual place of residence to be enumerated.
- Only the head of the household or responsible adult will be interviewed.
- Provided the head of household with your particulars, before you leave the house
- All children, babies, mentally and physically challenged persons will be enumerated.
- Babies born before the census night will be counted. Those born after the census night will not be counted.
- Outdoor sleepers (homeless) will be enumerated few hours before midnight of census night.
- Census officials will be identified by a census **T-shirt, Cap and Identification Tag**. They will also carry census questionnaires and materials.

THE DETAILS OF THE QUESTIONNAIRES FOR EVERY MEMBER OF HOUSEHOLD INCLUDE:

- FULL NAME OF INDIVIDUAL
- DATE OF BIRTH
- AGE
- NATIONALITY
- ETHNICITY
- RELIGION
- MARITAL STATUS
- LITERACY/ READ AND WRITE
- HAS THE PERSON EVER ATTENDED SCHOOL?
- THE HIGHEST LEVEL OF EDUCATION ATTENDED OR ATTENDING
- IS THE PERSON WORKING OR NOT
- TYPE OF OCCUPATION
- ANY DISABILITY

Information provided will be kept very confidential. The duration of the enumeration exercise is two weeks.
