2010 POPULATION AND HOUSING CENSUS

FACTS YOU SHOULD KNOW

Q1. Who qualifies to be interviewed in the 2010 census?

Head of the household or any responsible adult of the household.

Q2. Will everyone be interviewed on the same day?

No, the duration of the enumeration exercise is two weeks. If you have not been enumerated during the two weeks period then let the census officials know through the hotline provided at the back of this brochure.

Q3. What is census night? September 26, 2010.

Census night is the reference point to which all information refers.

Q4. Is it necessary to travel to one's home town to be interviewed for the 2010 PHC?

No, everyone should be enumerated at their usual place of residence. This will enable the government and the providers of essential amenities like electricity and water to know the kind and number of people they are dealing with.

Otherwise there will be inaccuracy with the distribution of the population especially if people travel to different locations for the census. For example, the providers of a facility like electricity will not increase the transformers in areas of high demand thereby resulting in power failure or low voltage.
