# REVISED ESTIMATES OF 2011 GROSS DOMESTIC PRODUCT AND

### FINAL ESTIMATES OF 2010 GROSS DOMESTIC PRODUCT

Gross Domestic Product is the etimate of the total value of final goods and services produced in the country during a given period.

The estimation of the Gross Domestic Product (GDP) is done in stages, with estimates generated at each stage being dependent on source data available. Estimates from each stage are progressively designated as projected, provisional, revised and final. It is only the final estimates that are not subject to further changes. The estimates in this bulletin present the final GDP estimates for 2010 and the revised estimates of GDP for 2011.

Final estimates for 2010 showed a growth of 8.0 percent over the 2009 estimates, which is 0.3 percentage points above the revised estimates for 2010. The change was mainly due to the inclusion of crude oil from the Saltpond fields and the initial production from the Jubilee fields in December 2010.

Table 1 below gives the summary of the changes that has occurred in the sectoral growth rates for 2010.

### KEY FINDINGS FOR THE REVISED ANNUAL ESTIMATES OF GROSS DOMESTIC PRODUCT FOR 2011

Revised estimates (i.e. review of the provisional estimates) of the GDP for 2011 showed a growth of 14.4 percent over that of 2010, in real terms. The Industry sector recorded the highest growth of 41.1 percent, followed by Services sector (8.3%), whilst Agriculture recorded the lowest growth of less than 1 percent (0.8%). Services sector remains the largest sector, contributing 48.5 percent to GDP (at basic prices). Industry sector is the second largest contributor (25.9%).

Crop production remains the largest activity, representing about one-fifth of total GDP (19.3%).

High growth rates were recorded in the following activities:

- Mining and Quarrying recorded the highest growth of 206.5 percent;
- Construction grew by 20.0 percent;
- Trade grew by 17.9 percent;
- Information and Communication grew 17.0 percent;
- Manufacturing recorded a growth of 13.0 percent;
- Other Community, Social and Personal Services grew by 13.0 percent.

### Activities that recorded declines in output:

- Forestry and logging declined by 14 percent;
- Fishing declined by 8.7 percent;
- Electricity grew by -0.8 percent


