Service Producer Price Inflation Rate in March 2024 is 7.6% The Service Producer Price Index (S-PPI)

The Service Producer Price Index (S-PPI) measures the average change over time in the prices received by domestic producers within the service sub-sectors to produce their goods and services. The S-PPI for Ghana reports price indices with an index reference period of March 2020 – February 2021 = 100. This release shows the annual (year-on-year) and monthly (month-on-month) producer inflation rates for services in three major sub-sectors (Transport and Storage; Food and Accommodation; and Information and Communication).

The S-PPI figure for March 2024 is provisional and is subject to revision when additional data becomes available. All other indicators are final.

March 2024 S-PPI

The Service Producer Price Inflation rate for March 2024 is 7.6 percent. This rate indicates that between March 2023 and March 2024 (year-on-year), the S-PPI increased by 7.6 percent. This rate represents a 6.0 percentage points decrease in Service Producer Price inflation relative to the rate recorded in February 2024 (13.6%). The month-onmonth change in the S-PPI between February 2024 and March 2024 is 0.8 percent. (Table 1).

The Service producer price inflation in the Transport and Storage sub-sector increased by 0.9 percentage points over the February 2024 rate of 11.2 percent to 12.1 percent in March 2024. The Accommodation and Food Services sub-sector rate increased by 5.5 percentage points to 20.9 percent in March 2024. The Information and Communication sub-sector recorded an inflation rate of 6.2 percent for March 2024.

Transport and Storage sector.

Producer inflation in the land transport sub-sector increased 5.4 percentage points from 7.9 percent in February 2024 to 13.3 percent in March 2024.

Inflation in the air transport sub-sectors decreased by 0.2 percentage points from -5.9 percent in March 2024. The postal and courier activities recorded an inflation (0.4%) in March 2024 (Fig.1).

Accommodation and Food Sector




Fig.2: Accommodation and Food SPPI (%)

The producer inflation in accommodation activities recorded an inflation rate of 19.3 percent in March 2024. Food and beverage service activities recorded a rate of 30.5 percent in March 2024 compared to 30.1 percent in February 2024 (Fig. 2).

Information and Communication Sector





Fig.3: Information and Communication (%)

Information service activities (25.0%) had the highest inflation in March 2024, followed by telecommunication activities recorded at the rate of (8.2%). Programming and broadcasting activities recorded the lowest inflation (0.7%) (Fig. 3).

Highlights

The year-on-year service producer price inflation is 7.6 percent in March 2024; the monthly change rate was 0.8 percent.

The Accommodation and food service sub-sector recorded the highest year-on-year producer price inflation rate of 20.9 percent, followed by the Transport and Storage sub-sector with 12.1 percent. The Information and Communication sub-sector recorded the lowest year-on-year producer inflation rate of 6.2 percent.

The Accommodation and food service sub-sector recorded the highest monthly inflation rate of 6.9 percent, followed by the Transport and Storage sub-sector with 3.0 percent. Information and Communication sub-sectors which recorded the lowest monthly inflation change of 0.1 percent in March 2024.

Fig.1: Transport and Storage
