



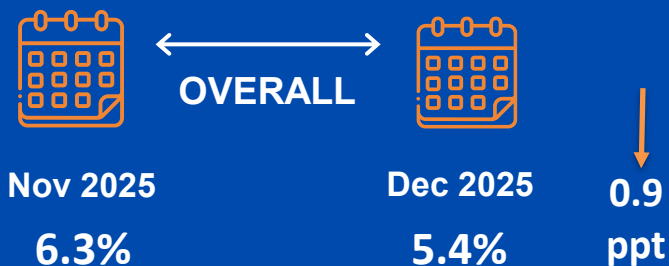

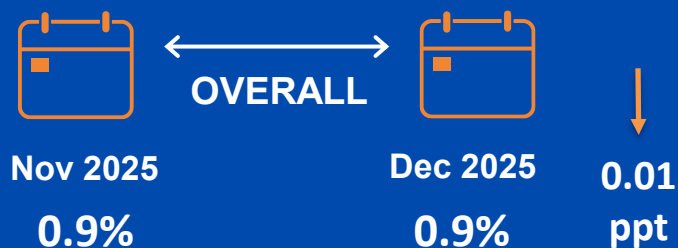

#### Year-on-Year (YoY)

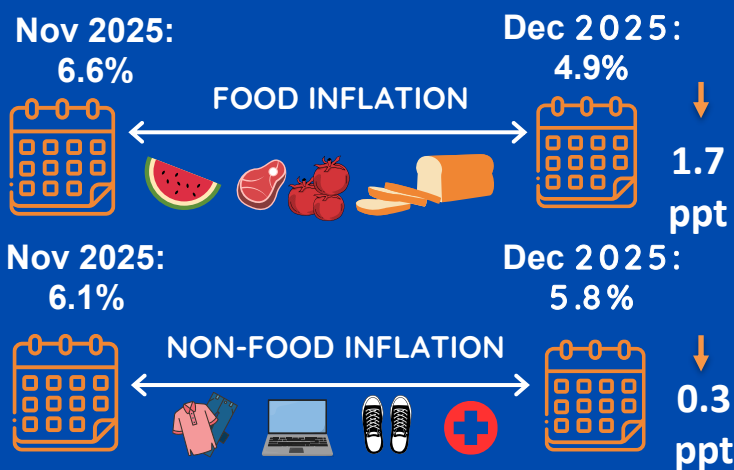


#### Month-on-Month (MoM)

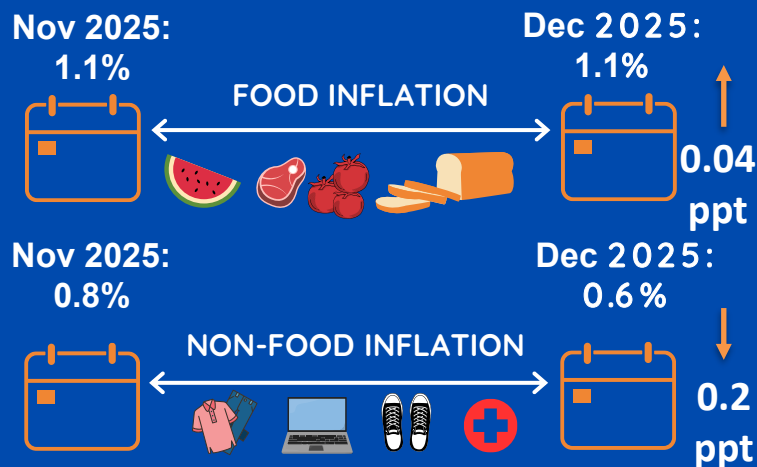


### FOOD VS NON-FOOD

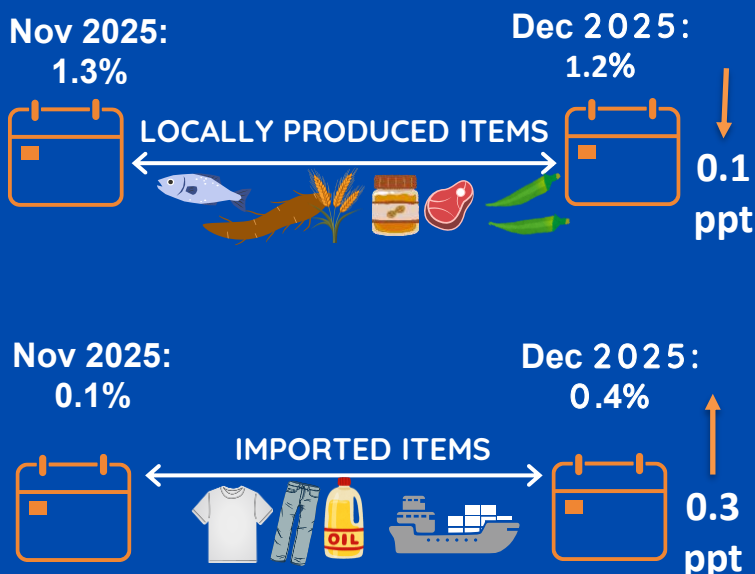

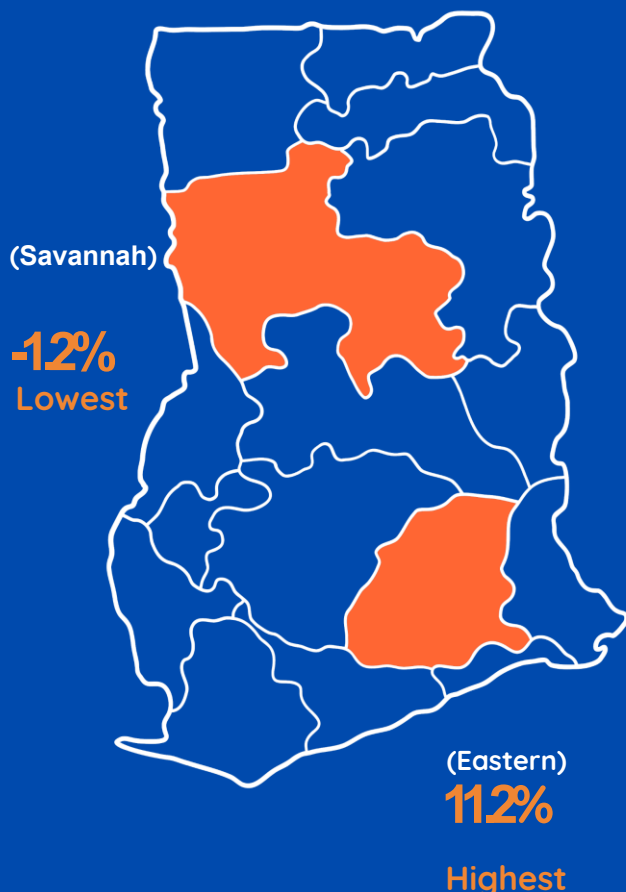
