

HIGHLIGHTS FOR JULY 2019

Inflation for July 2019 Increased slightly to 9.4%

The Consumer Price Index (CPI) measures the change over time in the general price level of goods and services that households acquire for the purpose of consumption, with reference to the price level in 2012, the base year, which has an index of 100.

The year-on-year inflation rate as measured by the CPI was 9.4 percent in July 2019 up by 0.3 percentage point from the 9.1 percent recorded in June 2019 (Figure 1). This rate of inflation for July 2019 is the percentage change in the Consumer Price Index (CPI) over the twelvemonth period, from July 2018 to July 2019.



The monthly change rate for July 2019 was 0.6 percent compared with the 0.8 percent recorded for June 2019.

Food and non-food inflation for July 2019

The Food and non-alcoholic beverages group recorded a year-on-year inflation rate of 6.6 percent. This is 0.1 percentage point lower than the 6.5 percent recorded in June 2019. Six subgroups of the food and non-alcoholic beverages group recorded inflation rates higher than the group's average rate of 6.6 percent. The subgroups were Coffee, tea and cocoa (17.5%), Fruits (11.0%), Meat and meat products (8.6%), Vegetables (8.4%), Sugar, jam, honey, chocolate and confectionery (7.0%) and Mineral water, soft drinks, fruit and vegetable juices (6.9%).

The non-food group recorded a year-on-year inflation rate of 10.7 percent in July 2019, compared to 10.3% recorded for June 2019. Four subgroups of the non-food group recorded year-on-year inflation rates higher than the group's average rate of 10.7 percent. Clothing and footwear (14.9%), Recreation and Culture (14.8%), Furnishing, Household Equipment and Routine Maintenance (14.6%) and Miscellaneous goods and services (11.2%). Inflation was lowest in the Education subsector (6.4%).

Regional differentials

At the regional level, the year-on-year inflation rate ranged from 8.5 percent in the Upper East Region to 11.1 percent in Upper West region. Five regions (Upper West, Brong Ahafo, Volta, Western and Ashanti) recorded inflation rates above the national average rate of 9.4%. Volta and Ashanti regions as well as Northern and Eastern Regions recorded the same inflation rate of 9.5 percent and 9.0 percent respectively

Year- on-year inflation by regions











Figure 7: Regional inflation rates (Year-on-year) - July 2019


